

Ward 9 December 11, 2017 Crime & Safety Meeting Statistics Provided by Peel Regional Police Inspector Dan Richardson

The statistics relate to the area in the general vicinity of the Meadowvale Town Centre.

Comparing the numbers from year to year, the calls for service have increased by 4%.

The 11420 patrol zone had 1842 violations from November 26th, 2015 to November 26th 2016.

The 11420 patrol zone had 1857 violations from November 26th, 2016 to November 26th 2017; less than a 1% increase from the previous year.

Theft from motor vehicle occurrences is the highest occurring crime type in the area since January 1st, 2017.

Analyzing violent crimes from year to year in the Meadowvale area, it was concluded that most violent crimes have decreased.

- The following violent crimes have decreased since November 26th, 2016:
- Robberies (where a person in a public area has been robbed) have decreased 21%
- Assaults with weapons have decreased 45%

Robberies (to a commercial premises) with offensive weapon or firearm have increased by 10% since November 26th, 2016.
