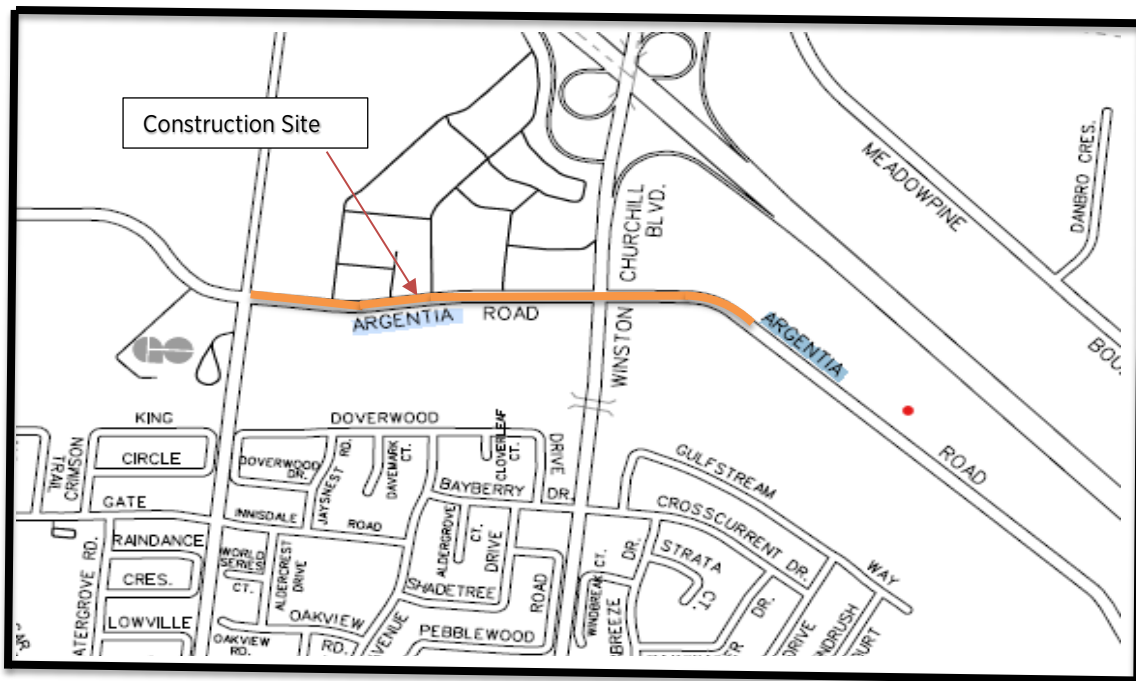


Cycle Track Construction
Argentia Road from Tenth Line West to East of Winston Churchill Boulevard

Construction Commencement : On or after **June 19th** to **September 29th, 2023**

Scope of Work

The City will be constructing new cycle tracks including street light replacement, new pad bus installation, traffic signals and associated work on both sides of Argentia Road from Tenth Line West to East of Winston Churchill Boulevard. These new cycle tracks will provide a safe and convenient pathway for cyclists.



What to Expect During Construction

Impacts	<p>Driveway access to properties will remain open during construction, however in order to complete curb, sidewalk and/or driveway repairs, it may be necessary to temporarily limit access to your area walkways and entrances. Please notify us if you have any special requirements, comments or issues.</p> <p>There will be some construction related dust, noise and traffic delays. The City will make every effort to reduce these impacts.</p>
Irrigation System	<p>Irrigation heads or other fixtures, including decorative fencing that interfere with construction and are located on City property, must be removed by the property owner. Fixtures will not be reinstalled by the City and the City accepts no responsibility for any damages to private fixtures placed on City property.</p>

Work Hours	Work will occur between 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.	
Traffic and Pedestrians	Roads	One vehicle lane on each side of Argentia Road from Tenth Line West to East of Winston Churchill Boulevard will be closed temporarily daily to traffic. Please follow traffic signage posted on-site.
	Sidewalks / Multi-Use Trail	Sections of existing sidewalks on both sides of Argentia Road will be closed and inaccessible from Tenth Line West to East of Winston Churchill Boulevard.
Transit Service	The following bus stops will be impacted by construction. Arrangements to temporarily relocate these stops will be completed by MiWay.	
	Bus service (Route 11, 38, 43 and 511) on both sides will be temporarily impacted during construction.	
Parking	On-street parking will not be available at this time.	
Restoration Works	The construction site will be restored with sod after construction has been completed.	
Utility Disruptions	Temporary disruptions to utilities (i.e. gas, hydro, water, telecommunications and cable TV) may be experienced. Every effort will be made to promptly restore service.
