CONSTRUCTION WORK IN YOUR AREA

New Water Service Replacement
Various locations in Mississauga, Brampton, Caledon **Project 25-1301**



Peel Region will be replacing the water service pipe that carries water to your property from the watermain under your street. Watermains are underground pipes that bring tap water from Peel Region's water treatment facility to your neighbourhood.

Your water service pipe will be replaced to prevent freezing issues that have been associated with your property in the past.

Construction schedule

Construction to start to **early September 2025**. This work will be completed one street at a time. Once the underground work is completed on all streets in each city/town, we'll begin repairing impacted driveways, boulevards, sod (grass), roads, curbs, and sidewalks. We expect construction and repair work to be finished by **June 30, 2026**. This date may change due to weather and other unexpected events. All work is warrantied for two years from the completion date.

Contractor working hours

The work will be completed by **Rymall Construction Inc.** under contract to Peel Region. Working hours are from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. These hours are consistent with local municipal bylaws and help shorten the amount of time construction is in your neighborhood.

Construction safety

Construction zones require extra caution to keep everyone safe. Be aware of your surroundings when driving, walking, or biking near the construction area. Watch for construction crews and other road users, slow down, and consider other routes. Visit **peelregion.ca/workzonesafety** for more information.
